Qualifying for Lifeline:

- 1. Based on Income (Income must be 135% or less than the federal poverty guidelines)
- 2. Participation in a qualifying federal assistance program:
 - a. SNAP
 - b. Medicaid
 - c. SSI
 - d. Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA)
 - e. Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit
 - f. Tribal Programs

Comcast Recognizes that seniors are on a budget and cannot devote a lot of money to monthly internet service.

Requirements:

- Must be 62 years or older
- Must live in one of the current eligible areas (Contact Comcast to see if you are living in one
- Must receive state or federal public assistance specific to the area where you live
- Must not have any outstanding debt to Comcast that is less than one year old (if you have debt that is older than one year old, you may still be eligible)
- · Must live in an area where Comcast internet service is available, but not have subscribed to it within the last 90 days
